Definition: "The EYES of the LORD preserve knowledge, but He OVERTHROWS the WORDS of the FAITHLESS" – The account above in II Chronicles about King Asa is an example of God "preserving knowledge" or in other words, protecting and delivering His faithful believers, but how He "OVERTHROWS the WORDS of the FAITHLESS," or in other words, He allows them to suffer the consequences of their own CHOICES and ACTIONS. King Asa had at one time been a FAITHFUL believer and had trusted the Lord to deliver him and the kingdom of Judah from their enemies. Later in life, King Asa turned away from God and trusted in his own abilities and in other people. In verses 12-13, it says he didn't even trust in the Lord when he got sick (he became FAITHLESS - not believing God), but was angry at God, and went to the doctors instead. It says he died two years after he first got
