but also GOSSIPS and BUSYBODIES" — To be IDLE means you're not doing anything - not working, not studying, not helping others, but just hanging around doing nothing. The Bible talks about those who have too much spare time on their hands, and exhorts them to get to work doing something productive, and not be busybodies (meddlers) in other peoples' affairs. This idleness and too much time spent looking at other's lives means you are NOT working on your own issues and growing and maturing in Christ. Gossiping is taking it to the next level, as you tell others how badly this or that person is behaving, and how you would do it much better, and so on. Gossiping, or "evil speaking" as the Bible calls it, carries with it your prideful judgment of the person you are gossiping about, when only God can judge their mind, heart or motives.
